TWO WAYS TO OBTAIN A NIGERIAN VISA

1. e-Visa (Recommended for Most Participants)

Nigeria provides an **e-Visa platform** that simplifies visa applications for many eligible nationalities.

Steps to Apply for an e-Visa

- 1. Visit the official e-Visa application portal: https://evisa.immigration.gov.ng/
- Create an account and select your visa category (F4A Visa is recommended for international conferences, seminars, workshops, and short-term professional gatherings).
- 3. Fill out the online form completely and accurately (you can see the partner hotels here).
- 4. Upload supporting documents (see below).
- 5. Pay the visa fee online using a secure payment gateway.
- 6. Await the Visa Approval Letter with QR Code, usually within 24–72 hours.
- 7. Print the approval letter and carry it with you during travel.
- 8. Present it on arrival at your Nigerian point of entry for visa issuance.

Documents Required

- 1. Passport valid for at least 6 months
- 2. Recent passport-sized photograph
- 3. Return flight reservation or itinerary
- 4. Hotel booking or **proof of accommodation**
- 5. Bank statement or **proof of sufficient funds**
- 6. Official invitation letter from ICEGOV 2025 LOC / NITDA
- 7. Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (recommended)
- 8. CAC Certificate of inviting company

Visa Validity

- 1. Validity: up to 90 days
- 2. Permits entry and stay for up to 30 days
- 3. Usually **not extendable** inside Nigeria

Airport Entry Process (e-Visa Applicants)

At Nigerian ports of entry:

1. All travellers must complete the online **Landing Card** before or immediately upon arrival. https://lecard.immigration.gov.ng. Required details: passport, flight info, visa

category (F4A), and local contact address. Keep a **printed or digital copy** (with a QR code confirmation) to present at the airport.

- 2. Proceed to Immigration Control
- 3. Present your printed or digital copy of the Visa Approval Letter and Land Card with QR Codes
- 4. Present your **passport**, return ticket, and proof of accommodation
- 5. Your fingerprints and a photo will be taken.
- 6. Your passport will be stamped with a visa-on-arrival
- 7. Collect your luggage and pass through customs. Declare any dutiable items.

Important Notice

- 1. Apply for your visa at least **4–6 weeks** before travel.
- 2. Ensure your passport has **two blank pages**.
- 3. Use only official platforms:
 - i. eVisa: https://evisa.immigration.gov.ng/
 - ii. NIS general info: https://immigration.gov.ng/nigerian-visa/
- 4. Avoid unauthorised third-party agents.

2. Traditional Visa (Through Nigerian Embassies or Visa Centres)

Applicants who cannot use the e-Visa system or prefer embassy applications can apply through Nigerian embassies or approved visa application centres.

Steps to Apply

- 1. Visit the official Nigeria Immigration Service (NIS) portal: https://immigration.gov.ng/nigerian-visa/
- 2. Complete the visa application form online.
- 3. Print out your application acknowledgement and payment receipts.
- 4. Book an appointment at the nearest Nigerian embassy or application centre
- 5. Attend your appointment and submit the following:
 - i. Original passport
 - ii. Passport photograph
 - iii. Travel itinerary and return flight details
 - iv. Proof of accommodation and invitation letter
 - v. Bank statement
 - vi. Yellow fever card
- 6. Await visa processing (usually 2–5 working days)

Letter of Invitation

To support your visa application, the ICEGOV 2025 Local Organising Committee (LOC) will issue an **official invitation letter** on request. This letter will contain:

- 1. Purpose of visit
- 2. Event dates and location
- 3. Institutional endorsement by NITDA
